The *Virtual Climate Symposium* will be opened by **H.E. Shin Chae-hyun**, Permanent Representative of the Republic of Korea to the United Nations in Vienna, **Dr. Heinz Fischer**, 11th Federal President of Austria and Co-chair of the Ban Ki-moon Centre for Global Citizens, as well as featuring a video statement by **H.E. Following on the key outcomes of the UN Climate Change Conference (COP26) in Glasgow, a high-level panel will discuss the status-quo of the Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs), best practice examples and opportunities to increase efforts in transitioning to a greener and hydrogen economy in the Republic of Korea and Republic of Austria, and how to accelerate the implementation of the Paris Climate Agreement.
