Women have always been the backbone of the farming sector in Africa providing 60% to 70% of food production. Therefore, it is crucial to empower them to earn and have food security.



With the My SDGs DOKTA's mobile application, farmers can take a photo or upload a picture of their crop to the platform, and the platform will analyze if the leaf is healthy or not.



The application then provides them with causes of and solutions to the disease. This method is cheaper, easy to use, and more environmentally friendly than most monitoring machines.



This initiative will, thus, boost food productivity and has the potential to generate revenue and reduce hunger by aiding rural women farmers to produce and sell more food.
