Growing mushrooms on sawdust, Eti Farms integrates an innovative approach by reutilizing a waste product that is usually disposed by burning and releasing pollutants.



The project Feed Your Household by Eti Farms Global works to empower women in rural communities by training them on mushroom farming and how to incorporate mushrooms into their diet, how to process and market them.



So far, 17 women have participated in a two-month internship with Eti Farms Global and helped them run their own mushroom farm and establishing their markets
