ABOUT WOMEN'S AGRICULTURAL DEVELOPMENT FUND



Women's Group Farming (WGF) is the flagship initiative by the Women's Agricultural Development Fund active in Northern Ghana.



Its aim is to encourage career and businesswomen to own farms and venture into agriculture by farming with a group of other women.



Addressing two main challenges: women's lack of access to land for farming and businesswomen's lack of time available for farming.



Secured 63 acres of land in Gbrumani-tibogu and helped 13 women to co-own the land and start farming in 2022.



A competent farm manager who takes care of the day-to-day operations on the farm. The 13 women can comfortably farm without necessarily visiting their farms every single day.

VOICES OF WOMEN IN AGRICULTURE

Nadia Ali is the CEO of ZLB Enterprise, a social enterprise that creates a sustainable livelihood for women in the rural parts of Northern Ghana. She holds 10 acres of land within the 63-acre farm under the "Women's Group Farming project. She hopes to contribute to food security through the project.
