ABOUT UZOEBO AGRO-FOOD HUB



A solar powered solution that provides a cold room storage system to store farm products under right temperate conditions before the sale and distribution.



Women smallholder farmers are trained on hazard analysis and critical control points (HACCP,) food safety and hygienic principles to improve the quality of their farm products.



They practice using Uzuebo Agro-Food Hub's e-commerce platform to control and monitor their sales activities.



A total of 200 women farmers have been trained and 500 more women farmers will know how to use the e-commerce platform by the end of 2022.

Grace Akpa is a local rice vendor at UZOEBO NIGERIA. Uzoebro digital and physical food hub gave her more market access and enabled her to send local rice from eastern Nigeria to the other regions of Nigeria. As a result, she increased her sales and can afford to pay her children's university fees.
